38.08/24 Community Events Discussion

a) Newleaze Nature Day Celebration

Clerk gave an update on progress for the day and hopes to finalise things over the next couple of weeks. Concerns raised over parking. Suggested to contact local groups such as Brownies, Guides and Scouts.

b) Parish Photography Competition

Clerk advised the plan is still to launch at the Community Nature Day. Advice given on how to promote the competition including specifying the minimum resolution quality and advising that the rights to photographs will be signed over to the Parish Council.

Cllr Collins gave an update on the new walk to school. This includes 13 residents who will purchase trees to complete the walk. Cllr Collins proposed the £5,000.00 Redrow reserve grant

for the nature reserve be set aside in the next F&GP budget for the purposes of scarifying and reseeding the walk around the trees so it can be kept cut in future mowing plans. Also to fund wood cut furniture for the new forest classroom area next to the new school.

RESOLVED, all in agreement. Clerk to add proposal to next F&GP Agenda, Cllr Collins to obtain quotes.

40.08/24 Frenchay Community Orchard update

It was advised that One Planet Matters are ready to undertake the landing strip at Tuckett Field (as previously agreed). Noted that any costs associated with this work will be covered by the WECA grant.

41.08/24 Frenchay Woodlands and Nature Reserve – One Planet Matters

Cllr Kinsey advised that One Planet Matters would like to support the Parish Council in managing this area and to run workshops.
