
















**Walk from Newleaze Nature Reserve to Monks Pool Nature Reserve**





*Please note this walk might be tricky with a dog due to the stile at number 8 and the ground is uneven so you need to be steady on your feet to complete this walk.*




1.	Start at Newleaze Nature Reserve	
2.	Walk up Snailham Lane	
3.	Where path forks round to the right with a gate in front of you take the stile to the left	

<p>4.</p>	<p>Once over the stile go left and follow the edge of the field (keeping the hedge on your left hand side)</p>	
<p>5.</p>	<p>Go through the opening into the next field (following the path), keeping the hedge on your right-hand side now</p>	
<p>6.</p>	<p>As the path ends go over a small stile in front of you into the next field</p>	
<p>7.</p>	<p>Take the narrow grass path in front of you (not the wider path that goes left) heading towards the houses. This will take you to a stile</p>	

<p>8.</p>	<p>Climb over the stile onto Swan Lane</p>	
<p>9.</p>	<p>Cross Swan Lane to Green Lane opposite</p>	
<p>10.</p>	<p>Walk up Green Lane</p>	
<p>11.</p>	<p>Bear left on Green Lane at the fork (following the public footpath sign)</p>	

<p>12.</p>	<p>Green Lane becomes a public footpath – continue on this</p>	
<p>13.</p>	<p>Continue straight where the footpath forks to the left (don't go through the kissing gate on your left). The path heads downhill and becomes a tunnel through the trees</p>	
<p>14.</p>	<p>When you get to a concrete brick wall in front of you, continue on the path to the right of the wall</p>	
<p>15.</p>	<p>Continue straight when the path forks right. Head towards the fencing under the trees in front of you</p>	

<p>16.</p>	<p>At the fencing take the kissing gate to the left and continue on the path (views of St Michael's church spire to the left)</p>	
<p>17.</p>	<p>At an old wooden stile, pass through the gap into the field and take the path straight down, keeping the hedge on your right</p>	
<p>18.</p>	<p>At the bottom of the field follow the path round to the left and immediately go through the kissing gate on your right</p>	
<p>19.</p>	<p>Follow the path to a gate and bridge. Go over the bridge into Bradely Brook Nature Reserve</p>	

<p>20.</p>	<p>Follow the path to the left keeping the river on your left the entire way (don't go up-hill to the kissing gate)</p>	
<p>21.</p>	<p>Continue on this path all the way to the end (you will see our new nature signs on your right before you exit Bradley Brook Nature Reserve)</p>	
<p>22.</p>	<p>At the end, go through the gate and head left, over the bridge</p>	
<p>23.</p>	<p>Just after the bridge you will enter Monks Pool through the first kissing gate on your right</p>
