Cllr Serjent advised he had been invited, along with Cllr Jenkins to a photo shoot for the new Chatty Bench, in connection with the Carnival Committee, on Down Road. It is hoped the photo can be added to the next newsletter.

Cllr Dyer noted there had been considerable damage to an area of Monks Pool where the recent film crew had driven their vehicles. Clerk has forwarded photos to our contractor who will supply a quote for the repairs.

Cllr Whatley advised that Cllr Burton has confirmed that the application for Frenchay Museum is due to go to committee on 3rd March, with a site visit on 18th February. He will be attending committee with the chair of Trustees & others involved with the feasibility study. This was a millennium project and it is now the third application to be submitted. They are very keen to be able to enhance the setting of the Museum. Cllr Jones advised all the pavements along Mill Lane are now clear of brambles. He has also been requesting South Gloucestershire Council to try and encourage the relevant landowners to deal with the walls that are in disrepair.
