### 128.01/23 – To answer questions from Councillors

The ongoing issue of the worn white and yellow lines in Frenchay was raised. Clerk has contacted South Gloucestershire Council regarding this and also the start date for the installation of the speed tables which was scheduled to commence on 3<sup>rd</sup> January. The very poor state of the road surface on Damson's Bridge was noted, and also the drain which is constantly blocked. Clerk to contact Streetcare.

It was noted Streetcare has cleared all the overgrown vegetation along Sunnyside Lane in Hambrook.

Part of a wall has collapsed on the Bristol Road going towards the Hambrook lights and is blocking the pavement. Clerk to contact Streetcare.

Also the collapsed wall on Pearce's Hill, which occurred 2 years ago has still not been repaired. Clerk to remind Streetcare.

The repairs to the wall by Frenchay Village Hall have not yet been completed due to the
